The course fee must be paid in cash or by bank transfer.

<u>Visa</u>: In preparation for participation in our program, it will be necessary for applicants to acquire a Thai visa.

This is of primary importance as Chulalongkorn University will not be responsible for the process of obtaining the visa required while residing in Thailand. However, upon request,

Chulalongkorn University can provide a letter of admission for presentation to immigration authorities.

Health insurance: All participants are strongly recommended to obtain health insurance to cover the cost of hospital and dental treatment during their stay in Thailand.

Accommodation: Participants should stay in privately owned accommodation which is available for rent throughout Bangkok. Since all participants must make their own housing arrangements and it is not always easy to find appropriate accommodation immediately, participants should arrange to be in Bangkok some time before commencing their classes.
