



Chulalongkorn University Announcement

Regarding applications for students in the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program), Faculty of Arts for the 2021 academic year (Admission).

Chulalongkorn University is now accepting Applications for Students in the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program), Faculty of Arts for the 2021 academic year (Admission). Application process and selection criteria are as follows.

1. Applicant Criteria

- 1.1.** Must have completed or are studying at Mattayom 6 level or equivalent in a domestic or foreign educational institution.
- 1.2.** Must have met the minimum requirement for one of the following English language proficiency tests
 - 1.2.1.** TOEFL with a minimum score of 79 (internet-based) OR;
 - 1.2.2.** IELTS with a minimum score of 6.5 OR;
 - 1.2.3.** CU-TEP (Chulalongkorn University Test of English Proficiency) with a minimum score of 80.
- 1.3.** Must have met the minimum requirements for one of the following proficiency tests
 - 1.3.1.** CU-AAT (Verbal section) with a minimum score of 400 OR;
 - 1.3.2.** SAT (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing) with a minimum score of 450 OR;
 - 1.3.3.** ACT (English and Reading) with a minimum combined score of 31Proficiency scores described in 1.2 and 1.3 must not be more than 2 years old, counting from the last day of applications
- 1.4.** Must be an individual of good behaviour who can guarantee to the university that they are committed to study to the best of their ability and is willing to strictly follow all current and future university regulations.

Should it emerge that an applicant is missing one of the preceding criterial or have found to have provided false information in the application or false evidence in support of the application, the applicant will be disqualified from

this round of application regardless of whether the application has been successful or not. The applicant may also face criminal charges.

Applicants to the in the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program), Faculty of Arts for the 2021 academic year (admissions round) must not have already accepted an offer of place on the Thai Central Admission System (TCAS) first round for the 2021 academic year's admission cycle.

2. Number of available places

Chulalongkorn University will be accepting a total of 40 **qualified applicants** into the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program).

4. Applications and Supporting Documents

4.1. Application Process Details

Applicants with qualities as described in point 1 may apply for selection to become a student in the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) in one of two ways (Admission).

4.1.1. Applying in person

- 4.1.1.1. Applicants may request an application form at the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) office, room 712, 7th floor, Boromrajakumari Building, Faculty of Arts, or download the application from <http://www.arts.chula.ac.th/~balac/web/> **Between 8th – 22th March 2021**
- 4.1.1.2. Applicants must completely and honestly fill out the application, including attaching one 2-inch photo on the application, and one 1-inch photo on the applicant identification card. Photo must be face-on, without headwear or dark glasses, wearing polite clothes and no more than 6 months old. Both photos must be in the same clothes.
- 4.1.1.3. Submit your application with supporting documents as outlined in point 4.2 at the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) office, room 712, 7th floor, Boromrajakumari Building, Faculty of Arts. Paying a 1,000 (One Thousand) baht fee in cash at the Finance and Procurement office, Maha Vajiravudh Building, Faculty of Arts **between the dates of 8th – 22th March 2021** between 09:00 – 15:30 hrs (During official working hours and days)

4.1.2. Applying online at <https://www.arts.chula.ac.th/~balac/v2020/index.php/admission/>

- 4.1.2.1. Applicants may fill in the online application form at website of Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program at <https://www.arts.chula.ac.th/~balac/v2020/> from 8th – 22th March 2021 and have uploaded supporting documents according to point 4.2
- 4.1.2.2. After filling out the online application form and uploading supporting documents the applicants should double check the application before submitting the application form (**the application cannot be modified after submission**).

4.1.2.3. The applicant may pay the 1,000 baht application fee through **Bangkok Bank, Siam Square Branch, account name: คณะอักษรศาสตร์ จุฬาลงกรณ์มหาวิทยาลัย, account number: 152-4-21836-7.**

4.1.2.4. After paying the application fee, the applicant may submit payment evidence through the program's website <https://www.arts.chula.ac.th/~balac/v2020/>. The program will examine the applicant's application and inform the applicant of the result via email.

4.1.2.5. Applicants or a legal proxy of the applicants must bring the original and copies of the supporting documents according to point 4.2 to the programme by **25th March 2021** at the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) office, room 712, 7th floor, Boromrajakumari Building, Faculty of Arts (during official working hours and days). The programme will take this opportunity to examine the applicant's supporting documents. **If it is found that the applicant's document does not match the uploaded version in the application system, the applicant will be considered to not have met the minimum requirements and will be disqualified.**

4.1.2.6. The applicant must print out the applicant identification card.

Applicants are responsible for checking that the applicant meets the requirements as outlined in the announcement and give truthful information in the forms. If there are errors committed by the applicants, or if the supporting documents do not meet the requirements outlined in the announcement, applicants will be considered disqualified from the start.

4.2. Evidence and Supporting Documents

4.2.1. Application form for Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) for the 2021 academic year (Admission)

4.2.2. Copy of educational qualifications and transcript (signed certified true copy and show original documents)

- 4.2.3. Original English language test result document according to points 1.2 and 1.3 (In the case of SAT results, the applicant must request a copy of their result from The College Board to be sent to the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program), Faculty of Arts, Chulalongkorn University using the institution **code: 6902**. The applicant should attach the order confirmation to their application form.
- 4.2.4. Copies of national identification card or passport (for non-Thai citizens) (signed certified true copy plus presenting the original documents)
- 4.2.5. Statement of Purpose in English, no more than 1,000 words in length
- 4.2.6. Document certifying student status at the applicant's current educational institution (if the applicant is currently in education)
- 4.2.7. Name Change form (Photo Copy – only if the names on the applicant's supporting documents and applications does not match)

Applicants must submit all documents, or the application will not be considered by the Faculty of Arts under any circumstances.

After the application has been made, it will be assumed that the applicant has made all the preliminary checks. As such, the Faculty of Arts will not refund application fees under any circumstances.

5. Selection Criteria

5.1. Selection Criteria for Interview

The Faculty will select according to evidence and supporting documents as outlined in point 4.2.

5.2. The Examination

5.2.1. Those with the right to take the written exam must attend the written exams as organised by the program. The exam will be on **1st April 2021** from 9.00 hrs until 11.00 hrs. There will be two subjects, these include:

5.2.1.1. Reading comprehension

5.2.1.2. English essay writing

5.2.2. Applicants must present their applicant's identification card and national ID card or passport prior to the exam or they will not be permitted to enter the exam room.

5.2.3. Those who commit acts of academic dishonesty will not be considered further.

5.3. Announcing Applicants Qualified for Interview

The faculty of arts will announce 100 applicants qualified for interview on 9th April 2021 on the website (<https://www.arts.chula.ac.th/~balac/v2020/index.php/news/>) with details for the interview.

The top 100 applicants are selected based on their written examination scores. In the event that the last qualifying applicants have equal scores, there may be more than 100 applicants qualified for interview.

5.4. Interview

Applicants qualified for an interview will be examined between 17th – 18th April 2021 at Maha Chakri Sirindhorn Building, Faculty of Arts, Chulalongkorn University. If an applicant does not report for interview, that applicant will be disqualified.

5.5. Assessment Criteria for Interviewed Applicants

The Faculty of Arts will consider applicants who have passed the interview process through interview score. The Faculty will use the score weighing below.

5.5.1 Written Exam Score 70 Percent

5.5.2 Interview Score 30 Percent

5.6. Announcement of Applicants who Have Passed the Interview

The faculty of Arts will announce applicants who have passed the interview on 23th April 2021 on the BALAC website (<https://www.arts.chula.ac.th/~balac/v2020/index.php/news/>).

The faculty may announce exactly the number of applicants who have passed the interview according to this announcement or more, in the event that the last qualifying applicants have equal scores.

5.7. Accepting Offer of Place

Applicants who have passed the interview **must report to accept offer of place at the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) office, room 712, 7th floor, Boromrajakumari Building, Faculty of Arts, Chulalongkorn University on 26th April 2021 between 08:30 – 12:00 hrs.** If an applicant does not report at the appointed time, they will be assumed to have rejected the offer of place. **On 27th April 2021 at 10.00 hrs, The Faculty will announce additional successful applicants based on score ranking until the announced number is met.** The additional successful applicants must report to accept offer of place at the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) office, room 712, 7th floor, Boromrajakumari Building, Faculty of Arts, Chulalongkorn University **on 28th April 2021** between 09:00-12:00 hrs. (if any).

This will be the end of the selection process. The faculty will not announce further successful applicants under any circumstances.

5.8. Announcement of Successful Applicants

The Faculty of arts will announce successful applicants on **10th May 2021** online at BALAC website (<https://www.arts.chula.ac.th/~balac/v2020/index.php/news/>).

Successful applicants **are required to confirm acceptance of the offer of place through the TCAS64 system between 10th - 11st May 2021**. Otherwise, the faculty reserves the right to cancel the applicant's admission status and may add the remaining slots in the second round of admissions.

5.9. Rejecting Offer of Place on TCAS64

Successful applicants to the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) for the 2021 academic year (admissions round) that have previously accepted an offer of place may, if they wish, reject the offer of place by doing so through the TCAS system between **12th - 13th May 2021**.

5.10. Announcement of Applicants who have Confirmed Acceptance of Offer of Place on TCAS64

Chulalongkorn University will announce applicants who have confirmed acceptance of offer of place on TCAS64 the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) for the 2019 academic year (admissions round) on **15th May 2021**, at **BALAC website** (<https://www.arts.chula.ac.th/~balac/v2020/index.php/news/>).

Applicants with the right to study must **report to confirm their acceptance of the offer of place and pay their confirmation fee on 17th May 2021** at the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) office, room 712, 7th floor, Boromrajakumari Building, Faculty of Arts, between 08.30 – 12.00 hrs. Applicants with the right to study must show evidence of successfully completing Mattayom 6 or equivalent on the reporting day. In the event that permission was given to extend while the applicant waits for examination results for Mattayom 6 or equivalent, the applicant shall present this evidence **no later than the 6th August 2021**. If the applicant fails to do this their right to study will be rescinded.

5.11. Announcement of Applicants with the Right to Study

Chulalongkorn University will announce applicants with the right to study the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) for the 2021 academic year (admissions round) on **21st May 2021** at **BALAC website** (<https://www.arts.chula.ac.th/~balac/v2020/index.php/news/>).

The Committee's Decision is final.

6. Conditions of Study

An individual must have completed Mattayom 6 or equivalent to be qualified to register as a student of Chulalongkorn University

Individuals who have completed their education at an international school or a foreign school that was not certified by the Ministry of Education must have their qualification certified by

Chulalongkorn University as being equal to a qualification according to the Ministry of Education's Basic Education Core Curriculum.

Successful Applicants will not be granted leave to study overseas within the first semester of their first year of study under any circumstances

7. University Fees and Extra Surcharges

University fees and surcharges will be charged according to announcements by Chulalongkorn University
