### Required Documents

1. A completed application form
2. 2 references (they could be from your lecturer, advisor, employer, etc.)
3. An up-to-date transcript of academic records (students should have 2.75 GPAX at a minimum in order to apply for the program)
4. An English proficiency score record (see the information on partner universities on page 3)
5. A copy of your passport
6. Study plan/description of academic interests
7. An 1-inch-colored photo taken no more than six months in polite attire or a civil servant's uniform, attached to the application form

### Process

- Submit application and required documents to International Division, Faculty of Arts at [exchange.artschula@gmail.com](mailto:exchange.artschula@gmail.com)  
Your submission must be made as a scanned PDF file (please compile all the documents in 1 file)  
There is no need for you to submit the hard copy.
- The Faculty deserves the right to make a final decision should the number of applicants exceeds the number allocated by partner universities.



- The Faculty will nominate and send the details of candidates to host universities in line with the timeframe designated by each university.
- For some universities that require an application through their online portal, the Faculty will send the students necessary information once the decision is made.
- Once approved, students will be notified, and letters of notification will be given for their visa application by the partner university.
- Once officially accepted, students may buy flight tickets, travel, and health insurance.
- Availability of accommodation is dependent upon the resources of each university.
- Students may need to take a close look at specific requirements stipulated by each host university by themselves at <https://qrgo.page.link/auLRf>



**Remark:** Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, please study the Student Exchange Policy as attached carefully. Successful candidates who are to participate in the outbound program are required to show that they have received 2 doses of Covid-19 vaccine, along with a study plan, a training plan, an overseas action plan, a COVID-19 infection prevention plan, a COVID-19 action plan in case of infection, and a plan showing overseas medical and treatment coverage.
