

Note on Electives: Students are allowed to take a maximum of 2 courses from the other concentration or from other M.A. programs offered by Chulalongkorn University, on the condition that the subjects are related to their concentration.

Academic System: Full-time, weekday program

Period of Study: approximately 2 years for Plan B, one additional semester for Plan A

Admission Requirements:

1. B.A. in any field with a GPAX of at least 2.75
2. A score of at least 80 on the TOEFL iBT, 6.5 on the IELTS or 80 on the CU-TEP

Admission Procedure:

1. Applicants must submit an application form, a transcript, a TOEFL/IELTS/CU-TEP test score report, a 300 to 350 – word statement of purpose, a one-page resume, and two letters of recommendation.

Plan A: Thesis Plan

- Coursework (24 credits)

Plan B: Non-thesis Plan

- Coursework only (36 credits)

 - 1 seminar
 - 6 electives
 - Special research
 - Comprehensive examination

- Suitable for those who aim for broader knowledge of English language studies or English literature
