# **Admission requirements**

We are looking for applicants with strong academic records and/or solid professional experience from diverse backgrounds. Since most materials and a large part of the lectures will be conducted in English, English competency is required to be admitted in this program. Proficiency in Thai is recommended but not required.

An applicant must meet one of the following academic qualifications:

- 1. Have a bachelor's degree in any field of study with a minimum GPAX of 2.5 or equivalent
- 2. Have a valid English language proficiency test score:
  - TOEFL (PBT)  $\geq$  500, *or*
  - TOEFL (iBT)  $\geq$  60, *or*
  - IELTS  $\geq$  5.0, or
  - CU-TEP  $\geq 60$

Exemptions from English proficiency requirement will be considered for applicants who have studied in an English-taught program.

Applicants who pass the initial screening will be contacted to set up an online interview by our faculty members.

# **Admission requirements**

We are looking for applicants with strong academic records and/or solid professional experience from diverse backgrounds. Since most materials and a large part of the lectures will be conducted in English, English competency is required to be admitted in this program. Proficiency in Thai is recommended but not required.

An applicant must meet one of the following academic qualifications:

- 1. Have one of the following educational backgrounds:
  - A bachelor's degree in a related field with a minimum GPAX of 3.00 or equivalent
  - A master's degree in a related field with a minimum GPAX of 3.25 or equivalent
- 2. Have a valid English language proficiency test score:
  - TOEFL (PBT)  $\geq$  500
  - TOEFL (iBT)  $\geq$  60
  - IELTS  $\geq 5.0$
  - CU-TEP  $\geq 60$

Exemptions from English proficiency requirement will be considered for applicants who have studied in an English-taught program.

Applicants who pass the initial screening will be contacted to set up an online interview by our faculty members.

It should also give a brief literature review, and a clear work plan.
- 7. A two-paged statement of purpose
- 8. A copy of valid TOEFL, IELTS, or CU-TEP score report (unless exempted)

Applicants who pass the initial screening will be contacted to set up a written examination on foundations in linguistics as well as an online interview by our faculty members.
