 - 1.2 For students from Asian countries, the airfare of each leg of the trip must not exceed 12,000 Baht;
 - 1.3 For students from Europe, Australia and New Zealand as well as Africa, the airfare of each leg must not exceed 20,000 Baht;
 - 1.4 For students from North and South America, the airfare of each leg must not exceed 30,000 Baht.

Students are required to pay for their tickets and this amount will be reimbursed upon their arrival at Chulalongkorn University.

- 2. GPA lower than 1.80 in 2 consecutive semesters.
- 3. Absence of scholarship recipients without notice or reasonable explanation.

 - 6. Applicants must be in good health.

2. The recipients are not permitted to accept any employment in Thailand during the term of their scholarships.

3. The recipients are not permitted to postpone a period of the scholarship acceptance as

proposed by Chulalongkorn University.

4. The recipients must residence in Thailand during the scholarship period;

In case of the scholarship recipient whishes to leave Thailand <u>during the semester</u>, he/she has to inform the University of his/her departure through the Advisor where he/she is studying and the advisor must give assurance that his/her absence will not interrupt his/her studies. Once the request is approved by the University, the scholarship recipient will be able to depart. In this regard, the University will not be responsible for the airfare. If his/her absence is more than 10 days, he/she will not be entitled to the living allowance for the month (s) of his/her absence. Students who leave Thailand before the term of scholarship, the University will not support both of living allowance and the airfare.

Term of Scholarships:

1 Semester (4 months)

Provisions of the Scholarships:

- 1. An economy class, round trip ticket, as actual paid. It should be noted that
 - 1.1 For students from ASEAN, the airfare of each leg of the trip must not exceed 8,500 Baht;
 - 1.2 For students from Asian countries, the airfare of each leg of the trip must not exceed 12,000 Baht;
 - 1.3 For students from Europe, Australia and New Zealand as well as Africa, the airfare of each leg must not exceed 20,000 Baht;
 - 1.4 For students from North and South America, the airfare of each leg must not exceed 30,000 Baht.
- 2. Tuition and Fees (special fees by the program is excluded)
- 3. Stipend and accommodation in the amount of 16,000 baht/month.

Health insurance:

Chulalongkorn University has a health service center facility. However, foreign students must have comprehensive health insurance policy to cover medical services in case of serious illness requiring hospitalization. If not, all medical expenses incurred will be borne by recipients.

Suspension and termination of scholarships:

These scholarships will be suspended or terminated for the following reasons:

- 1. Serious illness of recipients.
 - The recipient is deemed to be seriously ill and not physically fit to carry on with his/her studies.
- 2. Absence of recipients
