



**Chulalongkorn University Announcement Regarding the Bachelor of Arts
in Language and Culture (International Program)’s Application, Faculty of Arts
for the 2025 Academic Year (Early Admission)**

Chulalongkorn University is now accepting Applications for Students in the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program), Faculty of Arts for the 2025 Academic Year (Early Admission). Application process and selection criteria are as follows.

1. Applicant Criteria

1.1. Must have completed or are studying at Mattayom 6 level or equivalent in a domestic or foreign educational institution.

1.2. Must have met the minimum requirement for one of the following English language proficiency tests

1.2.1. TOEFL iBT (Internet-based) with a minimum score of 95 OR;

1.2.2. IELTS with a minimum score of 7 OR;

1.2.3. CU-TEP (Listening, Reading and Writing) with a minimum score of 90 OR;

1.2.4. DET (Duolingo English Test) with a minimum score of 130

1.3. Must have met the minimum requirements for one of the following proficiency tests

1.3.1. CU-AAT (Verbal Section) with a minimum score of 480 OR;

1.3.2. SAT (Evidence-Based Reading and Writing) with a minimum score of 480 OR;

1.3.3. ACT (English and Reading) with a minimum combined score of 34

Proficiency scores described in 1.2 and 1.3 must not be older than 2 years at the time of application deadline.

1.4. Must be an individual of good behaviour who can guarantee to the university that they are committed to study to the best of their ability and is willing to strictly follow all current and future university regulations.

Should it emerge that an applicant is missing one of the preceding criteria or have found to have provided false information in the application or false evidence in support of the application, the applicant will be disqualified from this round of application regardless of whether the application has been successful or not. The applicant may also face criminal charges.

2. Number of Available Places

Faculty of Arts, Chulalongkorn University will be accepting a total of **90 qualified applicants** into the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program).

In case there are less than 90 successful applicants in the first round (Early Admission), the Faculty reserves the right to add the remaining slots in the second round of admissions.

4. Applications and Supporting documents

4.1. Application Process Details

Applicants with qualities as described in point 1 may apply **online** for selection to become a student in the Bachelor of Arts Program in Language and Culture (International Program) by following the required details as follows:

- 4.1.1 Applicants fill in the online application form on the website of Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) at <https://www.arts.chula.ac.th/balac/> from 25th November – 25th December 2024.
- 4.1.2 Applicants scan and upload supporting documents according to point 4.2 (signed certified true copy) to <https://www.arts.chula.ac.th/balac/>.
- 4.1.3 The applicants should double check the application before submitting the application form (**the application cannot be modified after submission**).
- 4.1.4 Applicants will receive an email containing their applicant card, bank account details for the application fee payment, and a link to upload proof of payment.
- 4.1.5 The applicants may pay the 1,000 baht application fee (one thousand baht) through **Bangkok Bank, Siam Square Branch, account name: คณะอักษรศาสตร์ จุฬาลงกรณ์มหาวิทยาลัย, account number: 152-4-21836-7. The payment can be done either at a bank or through mobile banking.**

- 4.1.6 After paying the application fee, the applicant may scan and submit payment evidence through a link sent by email according to point 4.1.4.

Applicants are responsible for checking all the documents that are required for the Application stated in the announcement and give truthful information in the forms. In case of errors caused by the applicants, or if the supporting documents do not meet the requirements outlined in the announcement, applicants will be considered disqualified from the start.

4.2. Evidence and Supporting Documents

- 4.2.1. One 2-inch photo (photo must be face-on, without headwear or dark glasses, wearing polite clothes and no more than 6 months old.)
- 4.2.2. For current high school students, please upload document certifying student status at the applicant's current educational institution and transcript in English (signed certified true copy) OR an equivalent certificate issued by Council of University Presidents of Thailand (<https://hscs.atc.chula.ac.th/>).
- 4.2.3. For high school graduates, please upload a copy of educational qualifications and transcript in English (signed certified true copy) OR an equivalent certificate and a GPAX certificate issued by Council of University Presidents of Thailand (<https://hscs.atc.chula.ac.th/>).
- 4.2.4. Original English language test result document according to points 1.2 and 1.3
- 4.2.4.1 For IELTS results, the applicant must request the testing center to send their test scores electronically directly to the Bachelor of Arts Program in Language and Culture, Faculty of Arts, Chulalongkorn University, using the institution code: **190462**.
- 4.2.4.2 For CU-TEP and CU-AAT (Verbal) results, the applicant must obtain an original hard copy of their test score report from the Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center (3rd floor, Chamchuri 8 Building) and submit it to the program at Room 712, 7th floor, Faculty of Arts, Boromrajakumari Building.
- 4.2.4.3 For SAT results, the applicant must request a copy of their result from The College Board to be sent directly to the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program), Faculty of Arts, Chulalongkorn University using the institution code: **6902**. (The applicant should attach the order confirmation to their application form.)
- 4.2.4.4 For DET results, the applicant must request for their online result from Duolingo English Test to be sent directly to the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International

Program), Faculty of Arts, Chulalongkorn University using the institution code:

Chulalongkorn University BALAC, Faculty of Arts.

4.2.4.5 For TOEFL iBT (Internet-based), the applicant must obtain an original hard copy of their test score report and submit it to the program at Room 712, 7th floor, Faculty of Arts, Boromrajakumari Building.

4.2.4.6 For ACT results, the applicant must obtain an original hard copy of their test score report and submit it to the program at Room 712, 7th floor, Faculty of Arts, Boromrajakumari Building.

4.2.5. A copy of national identification card (for Thai citizens) or passport (for non-Thai citizens) (signed certified true copy)

4.2.6. Statement of Purpose in English, no more than 1,000 words in length (PDF file only)

Applicants must submit all documents, or the application will not be considered by the Faculty of Arts under any circumstances.

After the application has been made, it will be assumed that the applicant has made all the preliminary checks. As such, the Faculty of Arts will not refund application fees under any circumstances.

5. Selection Criteria

5.1. Selection Criteria for Interview

The Faculty will select according to evidence and supporting documents as outlined in point 4.2

5.2. Announcing Applicants Qualified for Interview

The Faculty of Arts will announce applicants qualified for interview on **8th January 2025** by email at **15:00 hrs.** with details for the interview. The Faculty of Arts may announce the names of applicants qualified for interview more than the number of available places in the case where it is expected that some applicants may decline the interview and not confirm their offer of place.

5.3. Interview

Applicants qualified for an interview will be interviewed between **10th – 12th January 2025** at Maha Chakri Sirindhorn Building, Faculty of Arts, Chulalongkorn University. If an applicant does not report for the interview on the date and at the venue above, that applicant will be disqualified.

5.4. Assessment Criteria for Interviewed Applicants

The Faculty of Arts will consider applicants who have passed the interview process through interview score evaluated by the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program). The Faculty will use the score weighing below.

5.4.1.	English competency	15	Score
5.4.2.	Interest in cultural issues	30	Score
5.4.3.	Critical thinking skill	30	Score
5.4.4.	Attitudes & academic potential	25	Score
Total Interview Score		100	Score

Passing Applicants must receive a total of at least 60% from 5.4.1., 5.4.2., 5.4.3. and 5.4.4.

5.5. Announcement of Applicants who have Passed the Interview

The Faculty of Arts will announce the applicants who have passed the interview **on 20th January 2025** by email **at 15:00 hrs.**

The Faculty of Arts may announce exactly the number of applicants who have passed the interview according to this announcement or more, in the event that the last qualifying applicants have equal scorer.

5.6. Accepting Offer of Place

Applicants who have passed the interview **must report to accept offer of place at the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) office, room 712, 7th floor, Boromrajakumari Building, Faculty of Arts, Chulalongkorn University on 22nd January 2025 between 08:30 – 12:00 hrs. If an applicant does not report at the appointed time, they will be assumed to have rejected the offer of place. The Faculty will announce additional successful applicants based on score ranking until the announced number is met on 23rd January 2025. The additional successful applicants must report to accept offer of place at the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) office, on 24th January 2025 between 08:30-12:00 hrs (if any).** This will be the end of the selection process. The Faculty will not announce further successful applicants under any circumstances.

5.7. Announcement of Successful Applicants

The Faculty of Arts will announce successful applicants on **3rd February 2025** by email **at 15:00 hrs.**

5.8. Confirming Acceptance of Offer of Place on TCAS68

Successful applicants are required to confirm their acceptance of the offer of place through the TCAS68 round 1 between **5th – 6th February 2025 according to the Council of University Presidents of Thailand (CUPT). Failure to do so will be considered a forfeit of place and the right to study in the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program), Faculty of Arts, in the 2025 Academic Year (Early Admission).** (For details on confirming an offer of place on TCAS68, please see <https://student.mycas.com>) In case the number of applicants who have confirmed their acceptance of offer of place on TCAS68 between

5th – 6th February 2025 does not meet the number of available places in this announcement, the Faculty reserves the right to add the remaining slots in the next round of admissions as it sees fit. This will be the end of the selection process. The Faculty will not announce further successful applicants under any circumstances.

5.9. Rejecting Offer of Place on TCAS68

Successful applicants to the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) for the 2025 Academic Year (Early Admission) that previously accepted an offer of place on 5th – 6th February 2025 may, if they wish, reject the offer of place through the TCAS68 system on **7th February 2025**. 5.10. Announcement of Applicants who have Confirmed Acceptance of Offer of Place on TCAS68

Round 1

Chulalongkorn University will announce the list of applicants who have confirmed their acceptance of offer of place on TCAS68 Round 1 on **11th February 2025** by email at **15:00 hrs**. Applicants whose names appear on the announcement **must report to confirm their acceptance of the offer of place and pay their confirmation fee on 14th February 2025 at the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) office, room 712, 7th floor, Boromrajakumari Building, Faculty of Arts, between 09:00 – 12:00 hrs**. Failure to do so will be considered a forfeit of place. **The Faculty of Arts reserves the right to not refund the confirmation fee under any circumstances.**

Applicants with the right to study must show evidence of successful completion of Mattayom 6 or equivalent on the reporting day. In the event that permission was given to extend while the applicant waits for examination results for Mattayom 6 or equivalent, the applicant shall present this evidence at the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) office, room 712, 7th floor, Boromrajakumari Building, Faculty of Arts, **no later than 31st July 2025**.

5.11. Announcement of Applicants with the Right to Study

Chulalongkorn University will announce applicants with the right to study the Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (International Program) for the 2025 Academic Year (Early Admission) on **21st February 2025** by email at **15:00 hrs**.

The Committee's Decision is final.

6. Conditions of Study

- 6.1.** An individual must have completed Mattayom 6 or equivalent to be qualified to register as a student of Chulalongkorn University. Should it be discovered that the applicant did not complete their required

education or does not possess all the required qualifications, their right to study will be rescinded and no application fee, confirmation fee, and university fee shall be refunded under any circumstances.

Individuals who have completed their education at an international school or a foreign school that was not certified by the Ministry of Education must present an equivalent certificate according to Announcement from Thailand's Council of University Presidents on Criteria for Equivalent Educational Qualifications. (Visit <https://www.mytcas.com/> for more details.)

- 6.2.** Should it emerge that individuals who have successfully registered as Chulalongkorn University students have been found to have provided false information in the application or false evidence in support of the application or in the registration, their right to study will be rescinded. The applicant may also face criminal charges.
- 6.3.** Should it be found that individuals with right to study at Chulalongkorn University have confirmed their offer of place in more than 1 program, their right to study will be suspended without prior notice.

7. University Fees and Extra Surcharges

University fees and surcharges will be charged according to announcements by Chulalongkorn University.
