## 2.1.2 Honorary Program

Students who wish to enroll in Honorary Program must have at least a cumulative GPA of 3.75 in the 1<sup>st</sup> academic year and have enrolled in at least 36 courses in the curriculum. If a student cumulative GPA is less than 3.75 but higher than 3.50 the consent to enroll must be granted by the Faculty of Arts Administrative Committee.

Students enrolled in Honorary Program must maintain at least a cumulative GPA of 3.60. If students are unable to maintain the cumulative GPA of 3.60 for 2 consecutive term, the student must enroll in Normal Program. The credits from Independent Study courses or Master's program courses in Honorary Program will remain valid.
