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### POSITION VACANT: LECTURER IN CULTURAL STUDIES

The Faculty of Arts at Chulalongkorn University is seeking to appoint a Lecturer in Cultural Studies to teach in its Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (BALAC) International Program. Applicants should have a completed PhD in a related field and be ready to start on 1 August 2017.

The Bachelor of Arts in Language and Culture (BALAC) is the Faculty of Arts International Program. Established in 2008, the BALAC Program brings together an exciting group of academics and students who participate in a wide array of interdisciplinary undergraduate studies in the liberal arts and humanities.

Applications are currently invited for a lectureship in Cultural Studies in the BALAC Program. The appointee will be expected to coordinate and teach a suite of subjects in the Program's core areas of Cultural Studies. In addition, the appointee will be expected to pursue an active research program, participate fully in the Faculty's research culture and

undertake appropriate administrative roles and curriculum development as required. A willingness to engage with and teach a culturally diverse student cohort is vital, and experience with university teaching in an international context would be an advantage.

### **Essential selection criteria**

To be eligible for consideration, applicants *must* have:

- A completed PhD in Cultural Studies or a related discipline.
- Demonstrated teaching experience at the university level.
- Excellent English-language communication skills.
- An ability to teach in two or more of the following areas: film and media studies; cultural theory; sociology of everyday life; global studies; textual analysis; gender studies; cyber studies.
- A willingness and ability to commence duties by 1 August, 2017.

### **Desirable selection criteria**

Preference will be given to applicants who have:

- A proven record of peer-reviewed research publication.
- Experience in the delivery and administration of university curriculum.

**Remuneration package:** The Position comes with a competitive base salary that is commensurate with qualifications, teaching and research experience. In addition, this salary could be supplemented by an additional “research payment” that is payable on fulfillment of demonstrable research output requirements (such as international peer-reviewed publications per year of contract)

**Application process:** Interested applicants are invited to lodge an application to the BALAC Program on or before 28 February, 2017. Applications should consist of:

- A covering letter that supports the application with reference to the selection criteria.
- A curriculum vitae detailing qualifications and experience.
- The names, positions, and contact details of two (2) academic referees.
- Documentary evidence to support academic qualifications.
- Sample of academic research/writing (e.g., journal article, book chapter, conference paper, research essay)
